Notions:


Rotary cutter, ruler, and mat
Sewing machine with walking foot or even-feed foot
All purpose sewing thread to match one color
90/14 Stretch or Ball Point sewing machine needle
Basic sewing supplies
Hand sewing needle
Pins




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


Team Spirit Infinity Scarf

Instructions:



- 1. Cut 12" strips lengthwise from both colors. Depending on the width of the fabric, the last scarf may be less than 12". (TIP: After cutting, place all your cut pieces in the dryer with a damp cloth on cool for a few minutes. The cloth will collect all the "Cuddle Dust".)
- 2. Pin one of each color of Cuddle right sides together on the long sides.
- 3. With a stitch length of 3.5, sew a 1/2" seam on one long side, being sure to backstitch at the beginning and end.
- 4. On the second long side, sew 4", leave a 5" opening, then sew the rest of the long side. Be sure to backstitch at the beginning, at the start and finish of the opening, and at the end. The opening will be used to turn the scarf right side out.



5. To easily turn the scarf so that the right sides are together, and positioned to sew the two tube ends together, put your hand in the inside of the Cuddle Scarf Tube, so that it's on your arm like a sleeve. Grasp the end on the tube and pull it back through the tube so that the two tube ends are together. Turn the inside tube end by one half turn, so that you have opposite colors together. Pin two layers of the tube end.

6. Place your tube end over the free arm of your sewing machine. Sew the tube end with a 1/2" seam.

7. Gently pull the scarf through the opening on the side. As this fabric is a knit and will not ravel, you may leave the opening unsewn, or sew closed with a slip stitch.
