This colorful and energetic quilt would be a great addition to any child's room. Two layout options allow you to stretch your creativity!

Fabric Requirements (as shown)

- Dig Dig Digital Cuddle® Multi
Main: 29" x 42"
- Luxe Cuddle® Ziggy Scarlet
Band: 3" x width of fabric
Binding: 6" x width of fabric
- Luxe Cuddle® Heather Stonewash
Contrast: 13" x 29"
Backing: 30" x 42"

Suggested Notions

- 90/14 stretch machine needle
- Polyester thread
- Felt tip marker or ballpoint pen
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Scissors and/or craft knife
- Long, flower head pins
- Fabric clips
- Walking foot
- Basting spray
- Batting, *optional*

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DIRECTIONS

- Read *Cuddle® Basics* before beginning.
- Fabrics will be referenced as *Main*, *Band*, and *Contrast*. Refer to *Fabric Requirements* on back page for specifics.

Cutting (Original Layout)

1. From Main, mark and cut:
 - 27" x 29" rectangle.
 - 8" circle for appliqué motif.
2. From Band, mark and cut:
 - 3" x 29" strip.
3. From Binding, mark and cut:
 - 3 (1¾" x WOF*) binding strips.
4. From Contrast, mark and cut:
 - 13" x 29" strip.
 - 30" x 43" rectangle (Backing).

Cutting (Alternate Layout)

1. From Main, mark and cut:
 - 1 (17" x 29") rectangle.
 - 2 (7" x 29") strips.
2. From Band, cut 2 (3" x 29") strips.
3. From Binding, cut 3 (1¾" x WOF*) strips.
4. From Contrast, mark and cut:
 - 2 (5" x 29") strips.
 - 30" x 42" rectangle (Backing).

*WOF = width of fabric

Assembly

Notes: If using batting, spray baste the batting to the backing before proceeding.

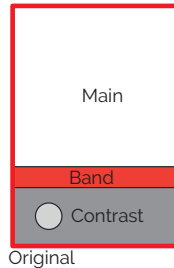
The remaining instructions will refer to this backing/batting sandwich as simply "backing."

This quilt is assembled using the Stitch-and-Flip Method. Strips are sewn to the quilt foundation through the strips, batting (if using), and backing—all in one step.

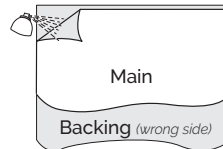
Arrange all strips with the nap going in the same direction.

Quilt Top (Original)

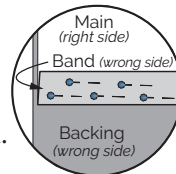
1. Lay the 27" x 29" Main rectangle, right side up, on the Backing, roughly aligning the top edges.



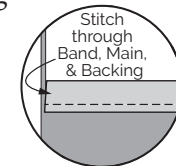
2. Fold half of the Main fabric back, spray baste, then flip it over to the Backing. Press to adhere.



3. Place the 3" Band, right sides together, along the bottom edge of the Main rectangle. Align raw edges and double pin.



4. Sew the Band to the Main fabric, stitching through the Band, Main rectangle, and Backing.



5. Spray the wrong side of the Band. Flip and smooth into place.
6. In the same manner, add the 13" Contrast section. Spray baste and smooth to the Backing.

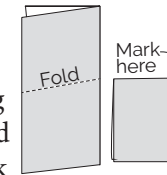
7. Position the circle appliqué as desired. Spray baste and double pin through all layers. Zigzag or straight stitch the appliqué edge.

8. Jump ahead to **Finishing**.

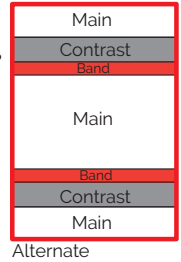
Quilt Top (Alternate)

Note: Arrange all strips with the nap going in the same direction.

1. Find the center of the 17" x 29" Main rectangle by folding the piece in half and then quarters. Mark the center point of the *wrong side*.
2. In the same way, find the center point of the *wrong side* of the Backing.
3. Center the Main piece on the Backing, wrong sides together and matching the center points.
4. Fold the Main fabric in half and spray baste. Smooth it back onto the Backing and press to adhere. Repeat for the other half.



5. Align the 3" Band, *right sides together*, along the bottom edge of the Main piece, matching the raw edges. Double pin, then sew—stitching through all layers.



6. Spray baste the wrong side of the Band, flip, and smooth into place.
7. Next, sew the 3" Band to the top of the Main piece.
8. Continue by adding the 5" Contrast strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.
9. Finish by sewing the 7" Main strip to the top and bottom and spray baste in position.

Finishing (Both Layouts)

1. Trim the edges and square up to 28" x 41".
2. Follow the *Binding with Cuddle®* booklet to complete your quilt.

Cuddle® Basics

1. Mark measurements on reverse side of Cuddle® with a felt tip marker or ballpoint pen.
2. Cut with a rotary cutter, craft knife, or scissors.
3. Shake cut pieces or put in a no-heat dryer with a damp washcloth for a few minutes to remove loose fibers.
4. Sew with polyester thread in the top and the bobbin.
5. Reduce presser foot pressure when sewing multiple layers.
6. Increase stitch length to 3.5–4 mm.
7. Double pin by using 2 rows of pins—the first row every 1½" along the seam line and a second row 1" to the left and parallel to the cut edge.
8. Backstitch at the beginning and end of each seam.
9. Seam allowances are ½" unless otherwise noted.
10. Use an even-feed or walking foot, if possible. It makes a difference!
