Cuddle[®] Flag Quilt

Approximate Finished Size: 57" x 47"

Show your patriotic pride with this bright throw. Stitch-and-Flip construction makes for quick and accurate assembly. Cut the stars with your die cutter or use the included template.

Fabric Requirements (as shown)

- 2¼ yards Luxe Cuddle® Hide Cardinal, for stripes and backing
- ³/₄ yard Luxe Cuddle[®] Hide Snow, for stripes
- ³⁄₄ yard Luxe Cuddle[®] Hide Royal, for field
- ¹/₄ yard Cuddle[®] 3 Snow, *for stars*

Suggested Notions

- AccuQuilt Studio Star #2 die (#50737) for die cutter
- 90/14 stretch machine needle
- Polyester thread
- Felt tip marker or ballpoint pen
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Micro-serrated scissors
- Craft knife
- Long, flower head pins
- Fabric clips
- Stiletto
- Basting spray
- Walking foot

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Cuddle[®] Flag Quilt

Approximate Finished Size: 47" x 57"

DIRECTIONS

Read Cuddle® Basics before beginning.

This quilt is assembled using the *Stitch-and-Flip Method. Each strip is* sewn through the strips and backing, all in one step.

Always place strips with the nap going in the same direction.

Cutting

Using Luxe Cuddle® Hide

- 1. From Cardinal, cut:
 - 2 (6" x 33") strips.
 - 3 (6" x WOF*) strips.

* WOF = width of fabric

- 2. From Snow, cut:
 - 2 (6" x 33") strips.
 - 2 (6" x wor*) strips.
- 3. From Royal, cut:
 - 1 (26" x 21") rectangle for field. Note: The nap should run down along the 21" edge.
 - From the remaining piece, cut: $-3 (1\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF^{*}) strips, plus - 3 (1³/₄" x 32") for binding.

Using Cuddle® 3

- 1. From Snow, cut:
 - 5 (5" x 5") squares. Cut a star from each square using the template or a die cutter.

Assembly

Create the field of stars

1. Arrange the stars on the blue rectangle as shown.



2. Spray baste and/or pin the stars to the blue field.

Note: Pin frequently! First pin in the center, then add pins in each point, then double pin on the edge.

3. Use a zigzag stitch to appliqué the stars in place.

Stitch-and-Flip the short strips

1. With nap going down, align a 6" x 33" red strip along the top edge of the wrong side of the backing. Secure in place with basting spray.

Note: For every strip, check that the nap goes *toward the quilt* Wrong Side Backing bottom.

Nap

2. Take a 6" x 33" white strip. With right sides together, double pin the edge to previous red strip. Use a ¹/₂" seam allowance to stitch the

strip in place. Wrong Side Note: Sew *through the* Nap white strip, the Wrong Side Backing red strip, and

- the backing.
- 3. Spray baste the wrong side of the white strip, flip it to the backing, and smooth it into place.
- 4. Repeat with another 33" red

strip and a 33" white strip. 5. With right sides together, sew Wrong Side Star Field the 21" edge of the blue star

field to the striped section.

Note: Have the blue nap running down, matching the striped section.

- 6. Spray baste the wrong side of the blue field, flip it to the backing, and smooth it into place.
- 7. Complete the flag top by adding the Wrong Side -Long Red Stripe remaining 3 red and 2 white stripes.

Finishing

- 1. Trim edges and square up the top.
- 2. Follow the
 - Binding with Cuddle[®] booklet to complete the quilt.

Cuddle[®] Basics

- 1. Mark Cuddle[®] on wrong side with a 6. Increase stitch length to 3–4 mm. felt tip marker or ballpoint pen.
- 2. Cut Luxe Cuddle® with a craft knife or micro-serrated scissors.
- 3. Shake cut pieces or put in a no-heat dryer with a damp washcloth for a few minutes to remove loose fibers.
- 4. Sew with polyester thread in the top and the bobbin.
- 5. Reduce presser foot pressure when sewing multiple layers.

- 7. Double pin by using 2 rows of pinsthe first row every $1\frac{1}{2}$ " along the seam line and the second row 1" to the left and parallel to cut the edge.
- 8. Backstitch at the beginning and end of each seam.
- 9. Seam allowances are ¹/2" unless otherwise noted.

Sew Together

10. Use an even-feed or walking foot, if possible. It makes a difference!
