#### Fabric Requirements (as shown)

- Digital Cuddle<sup>®</sup> After the Rain Watermelon *Main:* 29" x 42"
- Luxe Cuddle® Hide Watermelon

Contrast: 13" x 29"

Binding: 6" x width of fabric

Backing: 30" x 42"

• Luxe Cuddle<sup>®</sup> Chenille Navy *Band:* 3" x width of fabric

#### **Suggested Notions**

- 90/14 stretch machine needle
- Polyester thread
- Felt tip marker or ballpoint pen
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Micro-serrated scissors and/or craft knife
- Long, flower head pins and/or fabric clips
- Basting spray
- Walking foot
- Batting, optional

#### **GENERAL DIRECTIONS**

- Read Cuddle® Basics before beginning.
- Fabrics will be referenced as *Main*, *Band*, and *Contrast*. Refer to *Fabric Requirements* on back page for specifics.
- Before you begin, make a cutting and layout plan so all strips have the nap going in the same direction—from top to bottom.
- If using batting, spray baste the batting to the backing before proceeding.
- Remaining instructions will refer to the backing/batting sandwich as "backing."
- Quilt is assembled using the Stitch-and-Flip Method. Strips are sewn to the quilt foundation through the strips, batting (if using), and backing—all in one step.


#### **QUILT TOP—**Original Layout

#### **Cutting** (Original Layout)

- 1. From Main, cut:
  - 1 (27" x 29") rectangle.
  - 1 (8") circle for appliqué.
- 2. From Contrast, cut:
  - 1 (13" x 29") strip.
- 3. From Band, cut:
  - 1 (3" x 29") strip
- 4. From Binding, cut.
  - 3 (1¾" x WOF\*) strips.

#### Assembly

1. Lay the 29" x 27"
Main rectangle,
right side up,
on the Backing,
roughly aligning
the top edges.




2. Fold half of the Main fabric back, spray baste, then flip it over to the Backing. Press

to adhere. Repeat to adhere the other half.



3. With *right sides together*, place the
3" Band along the
bottom edge of the
Main rectangle.



4. Sew the Band to the Main fabric, stitching through the Band, Main rectangle, and Backing.


Band (wrong side)

- 5. Spray baste the wrong side of the Band. Flip and smooth into place.
- 6. In the same manner, add the 13" Contrast section. After sewing, spray baste and smooth to the Backing.
- 7. Position the circle appliqué as desired. Spray baste and double pin through all layers.
- 8. Zigzag or straight stitch the appliqué edge.
- 9. Jump ahead to Finishing.

#### **QUILT TOP**—Alternate Layout

#### Cutting (Alternate Layout)

- 1. From Main, cut:
  - 1 (17" x 29") rectangle.
  - 2 (7" x 29") strips.
- 2. From Contrast, cut:2 (5" x 29") strips.
- 3. From Band, cut:2 (3" x 29") strips.
- 4. From Binding, cut:
  - 3 (1¾" x WOF\*) strips.

#### Assembly

- 1. Find the center of the 17" x 29"

  Main rectangle by folding the piece in half and then quarters.

  Mark the center point of the *wrong side*.

  Mark the center point of the wrong side.
- 2. Next mark the center point of the *wrong side* of the Backing.
- 3. Center the Main rectangle on the Backing, wrong sides together and matching the center points.

- 4. Fold Main rectangle in half and spray baste. Smooth it onto the Backing and press to adhere. Repeat for the other half.
- 5. Align a 3" Band, *right sides together*, along the bottom edge of the Main rectangle, matching the raw edges. Double pin, then sew—stitching through all layers.
- 6. Spray baste the wrong side of the Band, flip, and smooth into place.
- 7. Next, sew the 3" Band to the top of the Main rectangle.
- 8. Continue by adding the 5" Contrast strips to the top and bottom.
- 9. Sew the 7" Main strips to the top and bottom. Spray baste in place.

#### FINISHING—Both Layouts

- 1. Trim the edges as necessary and square up to 28" x 41".
- 2. Follow the *Binding with Cuddle*° booklet to complete your quilt.

#### Cuddle® Basics

- Mark measurements on reverse side of Cuddle® with a felt tip marker or ballpoint pen.
- 2. Cut with a rotary cutter, craft knife, or scissors.
- Shake cut pieces or put in a no-heat dryer with a damp washcloth for a few minutes to remove loose fibers.
- 4. Sew with polyester thread in the top and the bobbin.
- 5. Reduce presser foot pressure when sewing multiple layers.

- 6. Increase stitch length to 3-4 mm.
- 7. Double pin by using 2 rows of pins the first row every 1½" along the seam line and a second row 1" to the left and parallel to the cut edge.
- 8. Backstitch at the beginning and end of each seam.
- 9. Seam allowances are ½" unless otherwise noted.
- 10. Use an even-feed or walking foot, if possible. It makes a difference!
