



## *Chevy Twist Cuddle*

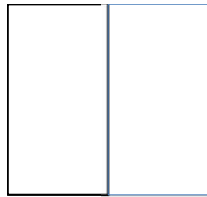

*Approximate sizes: 46 x 52*

*Note: All seams are 1/4"*

Prints	1/3 yard – 5 Lagoona Cuddle prints (DB1003-1; DB1000-1; DB1001-1; DB1002-1; DB1004-1)
Solid	1 1/2 yards of Cuddle 3 (Tiffany)
Backing	1 1/2 yards of Lagoona Cuddle print (DB1000-1)
Binding	1/4 yard of Cuddle 3 (Cherry)

From each Lagoona Cuddle print, cut two 4 1/2-inch strips. From solid Cuddle 3, cut ten 4 1/2-inch strips. Sew a print strip to a solid strip.. Subcut the strips into 8 1/2 inch blocks.



Sew in rows diagonally to create chevron pattern. Diagram 2 is a **partial view** of how the strips are sewn diagonally. See Diagram 3 for the **full pattern** with trim lines for finished quilt.

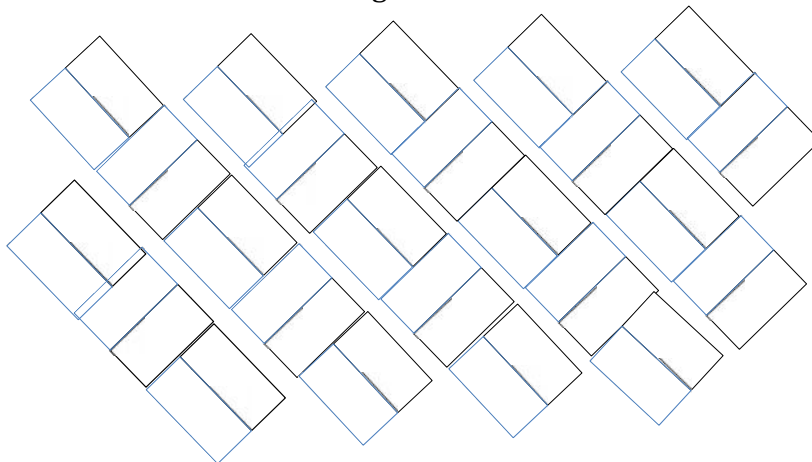
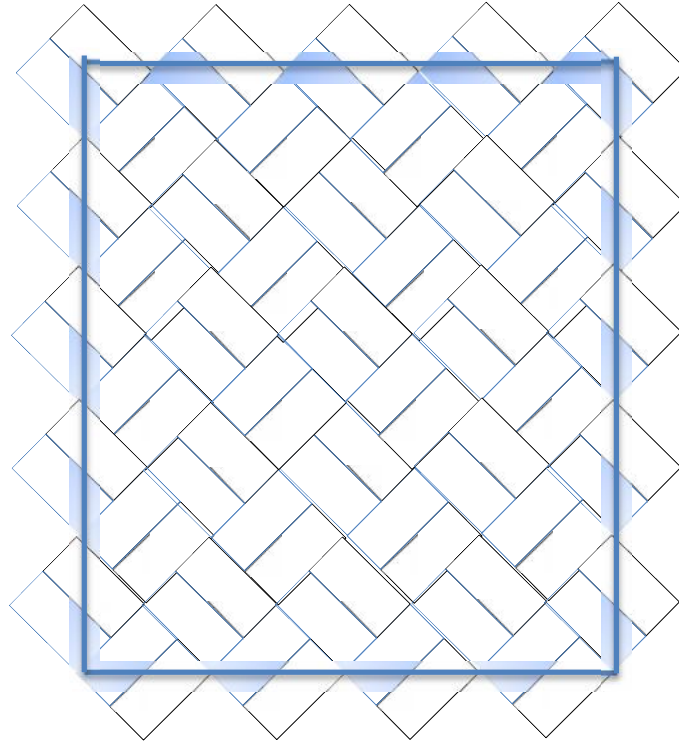

When finished sewing, trim edge angles to square up the quilt. Quilt as desired. Binding is cut in four 2" strips. For the flip and stitch method, do not trim edges until quilt is stitched to backing. Fuse the rows diagonally to batting and backing. Beginning at the center of quilt, sew diagonally through all layers, pinning and using spray adhesive to stabilize each row.
