

Colored Pencil Pillow

Approximate Finished Size: 6" x 21"

Fabric Requirements:

1/2 yd. Cuddle® 3 for Pencil Body and End

8" x 8" piece Cuddle® 3 for Pencil Tip

15" x 18" piece Cuddle® 3 Beige for Pencil Wood

Suggested Notions:

Polyester Thread

90/14 Stretch Needle

Walking foot

Long, flower-head pins

Hand sewing needle

12 oz bag Poly-Fil fiberfill

Stuffed bears are made with the Kimberbear pattern by Kimberbell Designs, made in Luxe Cuddle® Heather Quartz (lower rear) and Luxe Cuddle® Seal Pink (upper). Bear (lower front) is made with Cuddle® 3 Baby Pink, unknown pattern.

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Approximate Finished Size: 6" x 21"

Cutting Instructions:

Use patterns and a ballpoint or felt tip pen to trace each piece on the wrong side of the Cuddle®. Transfer markings.

With micro serrated scissors, cut out Pencil Wood, Pencil End, and Pencil Tip.

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut out Pencil Body:

Cut one 12 1/2" long x 15" wide (pick any color or print)

Assembly Instructions:

1. Pin Pencil Tip to Pencil Wood, right sides together, along curved edge. Pin at each end first, then subdivide until pinned at approximately half-inch intervals. Ease in as needed.

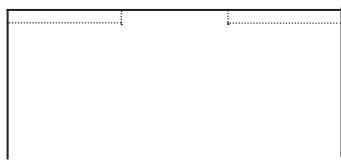
2. Sew with a 1/4" seam allowance at 3-4mm stitch length. Make sure to use your walking foot to help it feed through the machine easily.

3. Finger press seam open.

4. Pin sides together to create a cone. Sew with a 1/4" seam allowance, following curve at tip. Set aside.



5. Fold Pencil Body in half, right sides together to create a 12" x 7-1/4" tube. Mark a 3" space to leave as an opening to turn your pencil later. Pin along seam.



6. Sew together as shown, leaving a gap. By sewing right angles at gap, it will turn easier and pull in your seam allowance for easier hand sewing.

7. Using a pen or marking pencil, mark quarters at each end of the Pencil Body tube to help match while sewing.

8. Pin Pencil End to Pencil Body, matching marks on circle to marks made in Step 7. Pin from both sides to help it lie flat.

9. Sew carefully around entire end. Check seam to make sure it caught evenly all the way around the circle.

10. Turn Pencil Wood/Tip piece (made in steps 2-3) right side out and put tip inside tube. Match raw edges of Pencil Body and Pencil Wood, right sides together and pin in place.

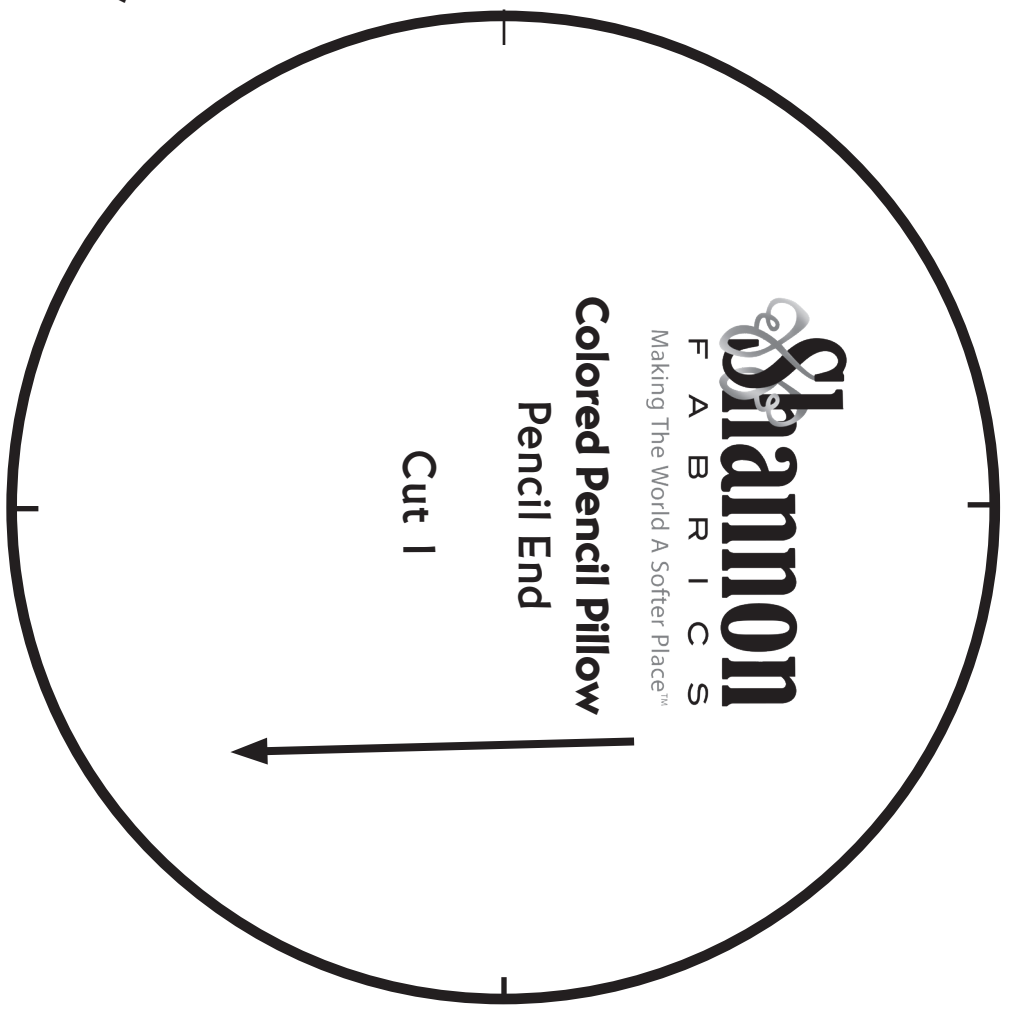
11. Sew and finger press seam open.

12. Turn entire pencil right side out through gap (see Step 4) in Pencil Body piece.

13. Stuff with fiberfill as desired. Do not over-stuff and stretch the fabric; Cuddle® requires less stuffing than cotton.

14. Pin gap and use a ladder stitch to hand-sew it closed.

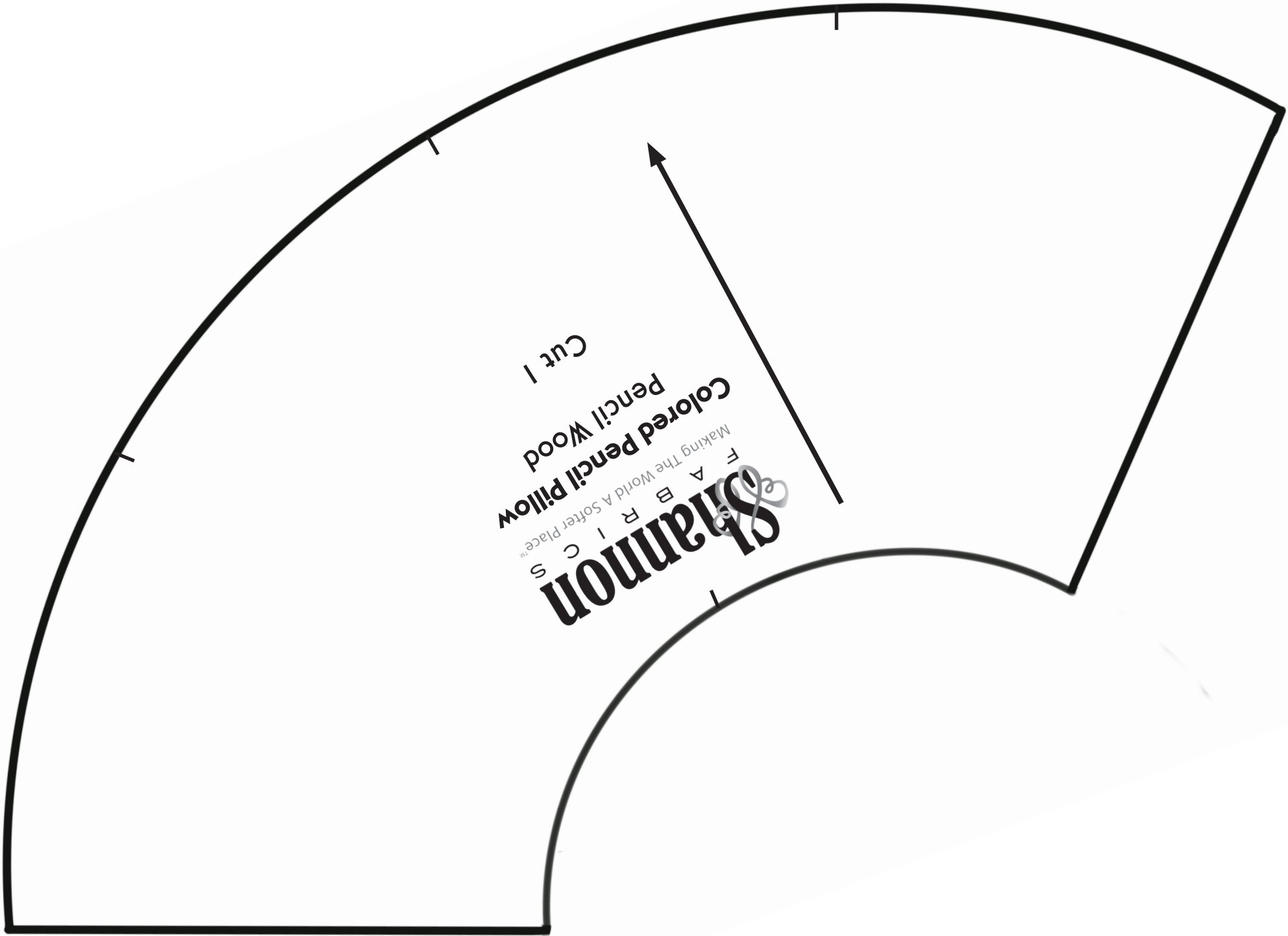
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Cutting Instructions:
