- 30" x 36" Batting (optional)
- Spray Adhesive
- 90/14 Stretch Ballpoint Needle
- Basic Sewing Supplies

CUTTING (Fabric List is on Picture) WOF= Width of Fabric

Center Fabric: 26" x 18"

• Cut (1) 25" x 18"

Inner Border: 6" x WOF

• Cut (2) 3" x 24" and (2) 3" x 18" strips

Outer Border: 10" x WOF

• Cut (2) 5" x 24" and (2) 5" x 18" strips

Corner Blocks: 7" x 29"

• Cut (4) 7"x 7" squares

See appliqué page for cutting directions

Binding: 6" x WOF

• Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips

Backing: 38" x 29"

No cutting required

BASIC TECHNIQUE AND SEWING METHOD

Use a 3/8"-1/2" Seam Allowance, as noted.

Quilt is sewn with Sew and Flip method. For more tips on this method, please visit our website.

- 1. Sew Inner Border strips to Outer Border strips, with nap going towards outer edge.
- 2. Appliqué pieces to Corner Blocks.
- 3. Sew Corner Blocks to each end of the 24" border strips.
- 4. Lay backing wrong side up, spray with adhesive, and lay batting on top. Mark center of batting and lay $18" \times 24"$ center fabric down.
- 5. Sew 18" border strips to bottom and top ends of Center Fabric, sewing through all layers. Spray, and flip borders down.
- 6. Sew side borders with Corner Blocks to center panel, matching seam allowances at borders. Spray, flip and square up sides.
- 7. Stitch in the ditch between the Inner Border, Outer Border, and Corner Blocks.
- 8. Stitch binding strip to edge using $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance, fold to back, and topstitch using serpentine/wavy stitch. Cuddle Binding Tips on back.



Appliqué Cutting Directions:

Appliqué Fabric: 5" x 29"

- 1. Cut (4) 5" x 5" squares from appliqué fabric.
- 2. Trace the template that goes with your quilt (Flower for Lola and Star for Theo) below onto the paper side of the fusible web four times. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 3. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as shown in the quilt photo. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 4. Place each appliqué on the 4 Corner Blocks square pieces.
- 5. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a Blanket stitch, blind-hem stitch, or straight stitch.
