## Pillow Appliqué

Finished Size: 12" x 12"; or as desired

- This pattern provides instructions and templates for the appliqué
- Choose a pillow pattern of your choice.
- Enlarge or reduce templates as desired. For a 12" square pillow, use the templates at 100%.
- Appliqué the pillow top before assembling the pillow.


#### Fabric Requirements

Fabric for pillow, as required (We love Cuddle® Dreamy.) 5" x 6", Cuddle<sup>®</sup> 3 White, Body 4" x 4", Cuddle® 3 Graphite, Head, Tail 6" x 6" Cuddle 3 Black, Spots, Tail Fringe

#### **Suggested Notions**

- Polyester stuffing, for pillow
- 90/14 stretch machine needle
- Polvester thread
- Long flower head pins





#### Directions

#### Prepare the Templates

- 1. Print and cut out each template.
- 2. Mark the topstitching and placement lines for the Spots and the Tail.
- 3. Cut out each fabric piece.

#### Attach Spots and Tail

*Use a wide (4x4mm) zigzag or blanket* stitch for all appliqués. In general, coordinate top thread color to appliqué.

- 1. Pin the Head Spot in place on the Head as shown on the template.
- 2. Appliqué the Head Spot.
- 3. In a like manner, pin and appliqué the four Spots on the Body.
- 4. After the Spots are appliquéd, pin and 7. Appliqué around appliqué the Tail.

*Note: The Tail will overlap Spot 2.* 

#### Appliqué the Head and Body

- 1. Arrange appliquéd Head and Body on the pillow top, as shown in the ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM, above right.
- 2. Pin the Head and Body in place, with the Head tucked underneath the top edge of the Body.

3. Remove the pins from the top edge of the Body and fold the Body back.



4. Appliqué the Head in place.

*Note: When turning corners or at* sharp angles, stop with the needle down before adjusting the fabric.

- 5. Add topstitching to define the ears.
- 6. Smooth the Body back up over the base of the Head. Pin in place.
- the Body, starting with the portion over the Head.

#### Add the Tail

- 1. Cut slits in the Tail Fringe. Fold lengthwise into thirds. Baste along the uncut edge.
- 2. With the basted edge of the Tail Fringe at the narrow end of the Tail, zigzag the Fringe in place.



## Pillow Appliqué

Finished Size: 12" x 12"; or as desired

- This pattern provides instructions and templates for the appliqué only.
- Choose a pillow pattern of your choice.
- Enlarge or reduce templates as desired. For a 12" square pillow, use the templates at 100%.
- Appliqué the pillow top before assembling the pillow.

#### Fabric Requirements


Fabric for pillow, as required (We love Cuddle® Dreamy.)

8" x 6", Cuddle<sup>®</sup> 3 Blush, Body, Tail

#### **Suggested Notions**

- Polyester stuffing, for pillow
- 90/14 stretch machine needle
- Polyester thread
- Long flower head pins





#### **Directions**

#### Prepare the Templates

- 1. Print and cut out each template.
- 2. Mark the topstitching and placement lines.
- 3. Cut the fabric pieces.

#### Arrange the Appliqué Pieces

- Place the cut fabric pieces on the pillow top as shown in the ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM, above right.
- 2. Tuck the base of the head and the feet under the Lamb Body.

#### Stitch the Appliqués

Attach all appliqués with a wide (4x4mm) zigzag or blanket stitch. In general, coordinate the top thread color to the appliqué.

- Appliqué the Heart/Tail on the Body where indicated.

  Note: When turning corners or a
  - Note: When turning corners or at sharp angles, stop with the needle down before adjusting the fabric.
- 2. Sew the Body in place on each side between stitching dot indicators.

- 3. Fold the top of the Body back and pin the Head in place.
- 4. Smooth the Body back up over the Head to check placement. Adjust as necessary. Pin Head in place.

Set Head in Place

- 5. Fold the Body back down. Appliqué the Head in place.
  6. Add topstitching Add Topstitching Lines Smooth Body Up Finish Body Appliqué
- 6. Add topstitching lines to define the lamb's ears.
- 7. Smooth the top of the Body over the base of the Head.

  Complete stitching around the top of the Body.
- 8. In the same manner, fold the lower edge of the Body up and pin the feet in place. Smooth the Body down to check the placement.
- 9. Appliqué each Foot in place.
- 10. Smooth the Body down over the tops of the Feet and complete the stitching.




#### Fabric Requirements

Fabric for pillow, *as required* (*We love Cuddle*\* *Dreamy.*)
7" x 7"", Cuddle\* 3 Blush, *Body, Tail* 

#### Suggested Notions

- Polyester stuffing, for pillow
- 90/14 stretch machine needle
- Polyester thread
- Long flower head pins





#### **Directions**

#### Prepare the Templates

- 1. Print and cut out each template.
- 2. Mark the topstitching and placement lines.
- 3. Cut the fabric pieces.

#### Attach the Tail


- 1. Pin the Tail in place on the Body as shown on the template.
- 2. Zigzag the Tail to the Body—starting at the outer edge and stopping 1" before the inner end.



#### Attach the Piglet Body

Appliqué the Body with a wide (4x4mm) zigzag or blanket stitch. In general, coordinate the top thread color to the appliqué.

- 1. Pin the Piglet Body in place on the pillow top, as desired.
- 2. Sew the Body in place around the entire outer edge.
  - Note: When turning corners or at sharp angles, stop with the needle down before adjusting the fabric.
- 3. Add the topstitching lines to define the piglet's ears.



Now that the appliqué is finished, your Pillow is ready to be assembled!
