

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Requirements based on 56-60" wide fabric

	2T-5T	6-8	10-14	16
Main	½ yd	⅝ yd	¾ yd	⅞ yd
Lining	½ yd	⅝ yd	¾ yd	⅞ yd

RECOMMENDED FABRICS:

- ♥ Heavy weight fabrics such as faux fur, cuddle and minky.
Lining should be lightweight lining fabric such as satin.

NOTIONS:

- ♥ Craft knife/razor blade/box-cutter, permanent marker. *(Optional)*

SIZE CHART & SIZING:

Choose size based on chest measurement, if between sizes, choose the smaller.



Acorn Vest



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Cutting tips for faux fur and cuddle/minky fabrics:

- ♥ Cut all pieces in a single layer.
- ♥ Be sure all pieces are cut with the nap going the same direction (usually down).
- ♥ Trace the pattern on the wrong side and cut with a craft knife, just through the backing.
- ♥ After your pieces are cut, throw them in the dryer for 20 minutes on tumble dry, no heat.


CUTTING

Fashion fabric:

- ♥ Cut 2 fronts, mirror image
- ♥ Cut 1 back

Lining fabric:

- ♥ Cut 2 fronts, mirror image
- ♥ Cut 1 back
- ♥ Cut 4 inseam pockets, 2 mirror image sets*




This vest is meant to be lined so all seams have a 3/8" seam allowance included. If you do not intend to line the vest you will need to remove the neckline, armscye, hem and center front seam allowances.

SEWING


Using a 3/8" seam allowance




- Align pockets RST to the vest front and back at the triangle markings. Straight stitch pockets in place. Press pockets out, under-stitch pocket seam allowance.



- Align vest fronts to the vest back shoulders, RST. Stitch shoulder seams. Repeat for lining.



- Align lining to fashion fabric, RST and pin. Straight stitch around center front and neckline as well as around armscyees. Clip into lining around the curved sections. Trim fur seam allowances to reduce bulk.



- Turn vest right side out by reaching up into the vest and pulling the front through to the back. Repeat for other side.
- Sew the side seams by aligning the lining side seams, matching armscye ends, pinning and then continuing that line of stitching up to the fur side seams and around the pockets. Repeat for second side.



- Turn the vest inside out again and align the hem. Straight stitch the hem, leaving a 4" opening. Be sure pockets are out of the way when stitching the hem.
- Turn vest right side out through the opening. Hand stitch opening closed.



How to print and assemble this pattern

Print this pattern at 100% with no scaling. After printing, check the 1" x 1" box to confirm accuracy. This is a no-trim pattern with layers. The pattern has a border on the bottom and right side. Line up the second page on top of the first, butting right up but not over the line. Tape in place and continue with page 3 on top of page 2, and so on.

You will notice there is a small piece of line that won't print. Cut like normal and fill in the line if you wish.

Note that there are two vertical guide lines. The solid line is for US printers and the dotted line is for international users who are printing on A4 paper. These lines can be turned on and off independently in the layers menu. *One of them must remain on so the pattern can be lined up correctly.*



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




View A In-seam Pocket

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


View A BACK


Cut 1 from fashion fabric





3/8" seam allowance included







