approximate finished size 15" x 15"

### **Fabric Requirements:**

16" square of Cuddle®, Cuddle® Dimple or Luxe Cuddle® Variety of Cuddle®, Cuddle® Dimple or Luxe Cuddle® 3-6 types of ribbon, 12" - 24" long 12" x 16" piece of crinkle material

### **Suggested Notions:**

Coordinating thread Stretch 90/14 machine needle Walking foot Rotary cutter & mat Scissors Long, flat flower-head pins Fabric clips (optional) Point turner

# Ribbon Lovey


Approximate Finished Size 15" x 15"

### **Cutting Instructions:**

Cut one 16" square (back)
Cut one 16" square OR four 8 1/2" squares OR 9 6" squares (front)
Cut 20-40 pieces in a variety of ribbons, each 4-5"long
Cut four 3" x 16" strips of crinkle material, optional

### **Assembly instructions:**


- 1. Embroider/applique any squares before assembly.
- 2.If piecing front, lay out squares as desired. Pin, right sides together, and sew using a 1/2" seam allowance and a 3.5-4.5mm stitch length.
- 3. Sew all squares together to create a 16" square for front.



4. Lay back square right side up,. Fold ribbon pieces in half and

use fabric clips to hold the raw edges of the ribbon and square together. Space them evenly around the perimeter of the square, leaving 1" from each corner empty to ease in turning.

5. Baste all the way around the square, using a zig zag stitch and 1/4" seam allowance.



- 6. If using, lay crinkle fabric at each edge on the wrong side of top square and baste in place..
- 7. Lay top square (pieced or solid) on bottom square, right sides together.
- 8. Pin well along edges and stitch with a walking foot, 1/2" seam and a 3.5-4.5mm stitch length, leaving a 3" gap for turning.
- 9. Clip corners, if desired, and turn right side out. Push out seams with a point turner. (If preferred, handstitch opening closed before topstitching.)
- 10. Using a zig-zag, serpentine or long stright stitch, topstitch around the perimeter of the blanket using a 1/4" seam allowance and taking care to close the opening left for turning.

Tip! Ask for crinkle material at your favorite quilt shop. It is generally sold in a one-yard package.
